Early Education Funding

Dear Parents

At St John Fisher Nursery, we offer both Universal (15 hour) and Extended (30 hour) early education provision.

All three and four year old children in Oxfordshire are eligible for 570 hours of free early education each year: this is known as Universal Entitlement.

Universal Entitlement is spread across the 38-week school year and equates to 15 hours per week. As this funding is statutory, there is no need to make an application.

Working parents may be also eligible for an additional 15 hours per week of free early education provision: this is known as 30 hour or Extended Entitlement.
