Today’s readings remind us of the many situations of need in the world. Pray together using the five finger prayer.

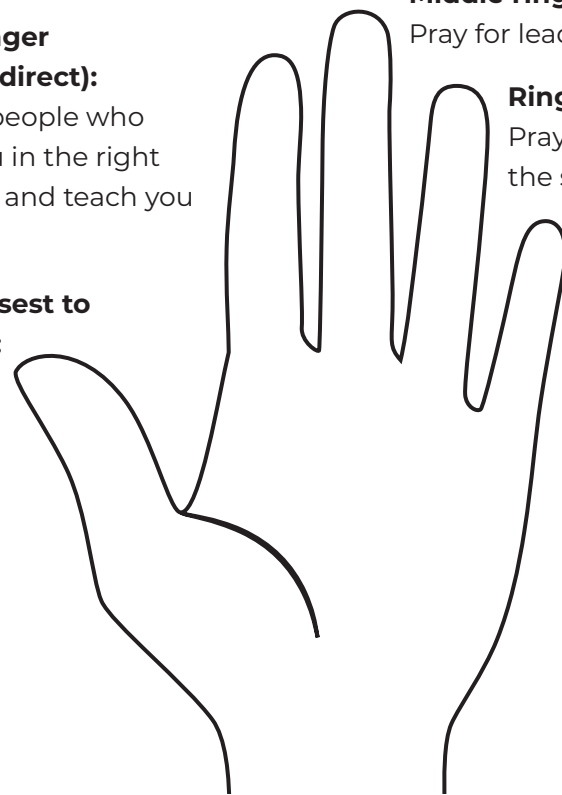
Index finger (used to direct):

Pray for yourself
